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

Reading

Phonics/Learn-To-Read Materials

Saxon Phonics Program

Grades K-2

This complete program combines integrated reading, spelling, & writing instruction for each grade. The kit includes the Teacher Manual, Teaching Tools, & Student Materials packet & there is a good mix of activities for different learning modalities. Because the lessons are scripted, it is easy to teach.

Sing, Spell, Read, & Write Program

Grades K-2

This complete multi-sensory, full language arts program includes songs, assessments, workbooks, games, prizes, flash cards, & an easy-to-use, step-by-step teacher's manual approach to phonics. The set includes 17 reading books, 6 cassette tapes, 2 workbooks, 1 teacher video training tape, & more.

MCP Phonics & Word Study

Grades K-6

This is a series of phonetic & word study skills from letter recognition in K to dictionary skills in the upper grades.

Phonics Pathways/Pyramid Reading

pk-6

Subtitled "A Complete Reading Program for Beginning & Remedial Readers of All Ages" this is a basic phonics approach to teaching reading. The lessons are 15 minutes a day, clear, & require no prep time. The multi-sensory approach is usable for different learning styles. The book covers prefixes, suffixes, contractions, plural forms, compound words, homonyms & homophones, homographs, & syllabication.

Explode the Code Series

Grades K-4

This supplementary series for beginning readers provides a sequential, systematic approach to phonics in which students blend sounds to build vocabulary & read words, phrases, sentences, & stories. Incorporates reading, writing, matching, & copying. Get Ready for the Code (A), Get Set for the Code (B), Go for the Code (C) & then moves into Levels 1-8. A comprehension component complements this series entitled, Beyond the Code 1-4 & used beginning with Level 1 workbooks.

Primary Phonics

Grades K-2nd

Through pictures, words, matching, organizing & coloring exercises, students learn to recognize & read in this easy to use program of six sets. Each set includes a workbook & 10 storybooks. Also available for each set are the comprehension series, Thinking About Mac and Tab, which gives practice on sequencing, recognizing story elements, & using context clues.

Teach Your Child to Read in 100 Easy Lessons

pk-2

Lessons are phonics-based, easy-to-follow, non-consumable & self-contained. There are no workbooks, no flashcards, nothing fancy- just one-on-one with your child 20 minutes a day. After 100 lessons your child should be reading at a 2nd grade level. This method uses visual clues in the first 80 lessons, but then they are dropped. (you'll want to find more beginning reader books to supplement).

Lexia Learning

Grades pk-5+

This is an online reading/phonics supplement for your child's development of reading fluency and vocabulary. It is meant to be paired with a formal reading program.

Reading Programs

Spotlight on Literacy Program

Grades 1-5

This is a comprehensive basal series. It contains lessons made for a classroom so it has more activities than you could ever use. First graders use picture books to begin the program, & then excerpts from literature for the stories. There are three workbooks that make this series a complete reading/language arts program: grammar, spelling, & practice (comprehension). Each grade has 5-6 teacher's editions.

Spotlight on Literature Program

Grades 6-8

This is a comprehensive basal series that uses parts of different literature books to expose students to various authors, genres, & themes. The workbook includes practice in vocabulary, literary elements, & comprehension strategies.

Junior Great Books Program

Grades 1 & up

This is a reading program using the shared inquiry method. The teacher acts as facilitator for the child. Students learn to question, debate, rethink, & analyze stories. The program integrates reading, writing, speaking, listening, & thinking.

Reading Supplements

Novel / Literature Units

Grades 2 & up

Students are involved through in-depth comprehension & story analysis of a novel. A teacher's guide & student workbook are available for some. A large variety of titles are in inventory.

Reading & Writing Sourcebook

Grades 2-8

This is a literature-based approach to help struggling learners build the strategies they need to become confident readers with an emphasis on developing stronger writing skills.

Five in a Row (New: Beyond Five in a Row-4th gr.+)

Grades K-3

This is a literature-based curriculum using unit studies to cover language arts, science, math, social studies, art, & character. A different picture book each week is the theme for learning with ideas, information, & activities to go along with each subject area. There are four different volumes to choose from.

Vocabulary

English From the Roots Up

Grades 2 & up

Learn prefixes & suffixes from Greek & Latin language by using flashcards. Over 100 Latin & Greek root words given to help build vocabulary.

Vocabulary for Achievement

Grades 3-8

This is a systematic approach to vocabulary development that teaches students to understand & use words effectively & prepares them for standardized tests. Student consumable with teacher guide.

Wordly Wise 3000

Grades 2-8

This is a consumable, vocabulary-building program based on frequency, grade level literature & textbooks. Word lists are accompanied by exercise sections consisting of: finding & applying meanings, using the right word, & a non-fiction narrative (that uses the vocabulary words in context) followed by questions. The books also contain crossword & hidden message puzzles. Teacher guides & tests are available.

Word Roots

Grades 2-adult

Greek & Latin roots, prefixes, & suffixes in a workbook format. 5 levels based on child's grade level.

Grammar

Daily Grams

Grades 2-8

These workbooks take about 10 minutes daily for a general review of basic capitalization, punctuation, sentence combining, and grammar. Completing only one page per day makes grammar review painless and easy. Workbooks may also be used with Easy Grammar. When student has difficulty with a particular concept, the teacher can use Easy Grammar for intensive practice on that concept.

Easy Grammar

Grades 3-8

These workbooks contain worksheets, reviews and tests to learn rules of grammar and practice skills of sentence combining, parts of speech, punctuation, and capitalization. This step-by-step approach is very structured and thorough.

English (Houghton Mifflin) – discontinued program

Grades K-8

This is an old state-adopted series. The program alternates grammar and writing units, making this a well-rounded text. Available in a workbook format.

First Language Lessons (for the Well-Trained Mind)

Grades 1-4

This is a classical approach to learning grammar & writing for the beginning learner. The program uses copywork, narration, memorization, dictation, & picture study.

Level 1 & 2 are contained in one book

Level 3 includes a separate teacher & student workbook

Level 4 includes a separate teacher & student workbook

Grammar for Writing (Sadlier)

Grades 6-8

A comprehensive grammar & writing program; includes student & teacher's editions as well as online resources for extra practice. Levels Red (6th), Purple (7th), Yellow (8th)

Writing

Great Source Writing Series:

This series of books is a top-notch program with good coverage of mechanics to help formulate ideas using the writing process. The 1-8 grade texts contain many charts, graphs, lists, & idea maps.

1. Write One

Grade 1

Discussions that are short, simple, and to-the-point lessons make this a good starting program for very beginner writers.

2. Write Away

Grade 2

Students begin to learn the writing process. There are also sections on personal, subject & research writing, reading & word skills, speaking & listening skills.

3. Write on Track

Grade 3

Delving deeper into the writing process, it includes more personal writing, subject & research writing. It also includes how to write realistic stories, fantasies, & plays.

4. Writer's Express

Grades 4-5

This is a handbook for young writers. It covers the writing process, historical documents, study skills, writing riddles, speaking & listening, but emphasizes all genres of writing.

5. Write Source 2000

Grades 6-8

"A Guide to Writing, Thinking, and Learning" is a language resource which stresses the fundamental principles of writing. The friendly, thorough, fun-to-read format contains lessons for various genres of writing, reading & thinking strategies, and tips on improving study & test skills.

Strategies for Writers

Grades K-8

An effective, research-based program that explains the writing process & provides students with the tools for developing effective writing skills. Instruction & assessment are rubric-based so students/parents are able to assess their work. Grade K & Level A-H.

Just Write (EPS)

Grades K-4+

This is a structured approach to creative writing. The series guides students through the writing process from initial idea to final edited & published narrative.

Write About Me & Write About My World

K-1st grade

Covers sentence development, uses pictures for aids, & the 5 senses to describe.

Just Write Book 1

2nd or 3rd grade

Focuses on learning to write stories.

Just Write Book 2

2nd or 3rd grade

Expands upon story writing covered in Book 1.

Just Write Book 3

4th+

Discusses 4 main writing styles: narrative, descriptive, expository, & persuasive.

Writing Skills

Grades 2-8

This program helps develop the essential writing skills needed to write research papers & essays. Learn to write letters, expository essays, outlines, & summaries. Grammar & usage exercises are integrated into writing instruction. One Teacher Guide used for all 3 levels.

Grades 6-8

This is a component to the Grammar for Writing program; includes student & teacher editions. Levels A-C

Spelling

Spelling Power

Grades 2-adult

It's all in one book. A chapter of research findings details the most effective methods of spelling instruction. Complete instruction strategies & directions for adapting to different learning styles and ages. The extensive word lists are the most frequently used & misspelled words. Program is based on phonics & spelling rules, not phonics alone. Directions for over 100 games & activities are included. Student is tested so teacher knows which list of words to begin. Student writes words for 5 minutes, practices words missed for 5 minutes, then may use them in activities. Workbooks are line-spaced differently depending on student level: primary, middle, & upper grades.

Spelling Workout (MCP)

Grades 1-8

This well-respected series is presented by phonetic construct in the early grades & spelling patterns in the upper grades. Levels A-H

Spelling (Steck-Vaughn)

Grades 1-8

This series is based on research of word difficulty & frequency. It incorporates a language arts approach to studying spelling so the student can use the word in a variety of workbook assignments.

Penmanship

Daily Handwriting Practice

Grades 1-8

This workbook contains 36 weeks of daily practice exercises. Half-page assignments on Mon-Thu; full page on Fridays don't overwhelm students. Available in: Traditional Manuscript & Traditional Cursive.

D'Nealian Handwriting

Grades K-6

This manuscript is a curvy, slanted form of writing which is supposed to make the transition into cursive handwriting easier for students.

Handwriting (Zaner-Bloser)

Grades K-8

These practice workbooks are traditional handwriting strokes to master manuscript & cursive. Series 2M contains more block printing practice; 2C moves into cursive sooner.

Italic

Grades K-6

This manuscript flows into cursive as the letters don't change; at Level C (2nd) they just begin to connect.

Math

Math in Focus (Singapore)

Grades K-8

This 2014 series follows CA math standards. There is also online components.

Scott Foresman California Math Program

Grades K-6

This is a 2001 series. It is complete & well organized.

Prentice Hall Pre-Algebra & Algebra Program

Grades 7-8

This series follows the CA math standards closely & is user-friendly. The teacher is provided with many excellent & well-explained examples. There is a wide variety of supplementary materials including practice books, assessment, & lesson plans.

Teaching Textbooks

Grades 3-High School

This math program provides direct instruction to students via a CD. Teacher Keys accompany the program. The Pre-Algebra, Algebra, & Geometry levels provide corrections & scores to the student.

Math-U-See Program

Grades K-8

This is a manipulative-based program that is very teacher involved for the student who needs to "see" & "do." The basic structure of the program is to work on a particular concept with a manipulative & watch a video on the first day & then complete problems the rest of the week.

A manipulative bag is checked out with grades K-2

Key To ___ Series *This is supplemental only

Grades 3-8

Students can work through this series without being confined to an age/grade program. The workbooks are kid-friendly. Topics include: algebra, geometry, decimals, fractions, measurement, metric measurement, & percents. A great choice for "mathphobic" students.

All About Spelling (1-8+) **a great spelling program for all students!

A multisensory approach so that no matter a student's particular learning style, a student will have success. The program follows the Orton-Gillingham approach whereby students learn phonograms, which are the sounds that a letter or letter combination make. For the teacher, the daily lessons are scripted. There are 7 levels to this program which are related to skill level, not grade level. Each level includes a Teacher's Guide & a Material Packet.
